It's official—I've reached the age where a night out sounds like a lot of fun, until it's time to leave the house. Suddenly, Dateline or 60 Minutes looks pretty appealing. Maybe you can relate.

But here's what I've noticed: whether or not we go out, we all love the invitation. An invitation means someone thought of us. It feels good to be included—whether it's a party, a wedding, a sales pitch, or even church.

Barna Group research shows something remarkable: if invited by a trusted friend or family member, 82% of unchurched adults would attend church. That's a huge number! But here's the staggering part—73% of those same adults say they've never been invited. Not once.


That should give us pause. It means that, for many, the barrier isn't resistance to faith—it's simply the absence of an invitation.

And as we look at Jesus' invitation to come. I want to challenge each of us to invite someone each week. Did you know that most salespeople will tell you it takes asking ten people before one says yes? (When I worked in sales, I tracked my "no to yes" ratio. My best was one in seven!) It is my prayer that inviting someone to hear the Good News of Jesus will become an easy and natural part of our daily conversations.

So who can you invite? People are longing for connection they just need someone to ask. Let's Say Yes to bringing others to Jesus. We have good news to share! Let's not keep it to ourselves!


DAYS TO DREAM: MINISTRY OF INCLUSION


